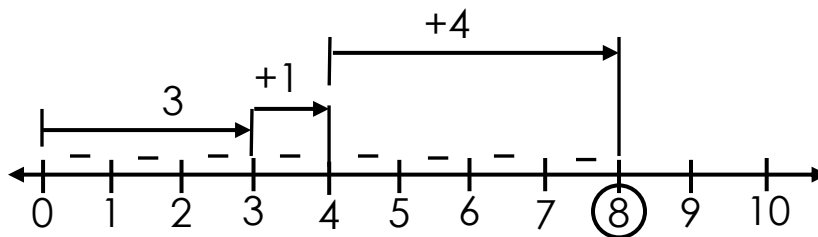

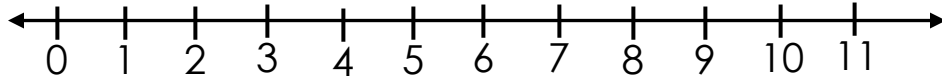
Steps

- Ring the answer and write it in the spaces provided.

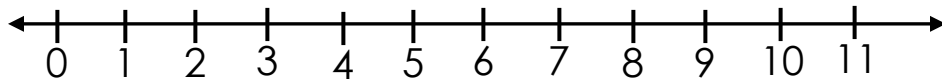
