Ethnic groups

What is an ethnic group?

An ethnic group is a group of people who share the same origin and speak related **languages**. Or

An ethnic group is a group of people who have the same origin and speak almost the same language.

There are four main ethnic groups of people in our division/subcounty. They include Bantu, Nilotics, Hamites and Nilo-hamites. Each of the above ethnic group has people who are grouped under tribes. A tribe is a group of people who share the same origin, culture and language. There are different tribes in our subcounty and they speak different languages. A language means a medium of communication. The Baganda speak **Luganda** as their language, the Banyankole speak Runyankole/Runyakitara and other tribes also have their common languages. The Bantu ethnic group is the largest and they are mainly farmers. The Bantu ethnic group has got a common suffix "Ntu" which means people or person and they are mainly farmers, the Nilotics are Luo speakers, Nilo-hamites are cattle keepers and Hamites ethnic group which is the smallest of all are cattle keepers.





